



GIO STADIUM TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS FOR MAJOR EVENTS

Dear Resident,

GIO Stadium will host a range of sporting and entertainment events in 2018, providing an opportunity for Canberrans to experience the excitement of live sport and entertainment on a regular basis.

To ensure there is minimal traffic congestion caused by the influx of spectators for these major sporting events, alternative traffic arrangements will be established for the areas surrounding the stadium. Modified traffic arrangements will commence up to two hours prior to gate opening times, and will continue throughout the event and up to one hour once an event concludes.

On game days, modified traffic arrangements will be implemented on Haydon Drive, Battye Street, Braybrooke Street and Masterman Street in Bruce, and residents living in this area may experience delays.

The ACT Government would like to thank you for your support of events at GIO Stadium, and your patience and understanding during these events.

AVOIDING TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ON EVENT DAYS:

Entering the Bruce precinct via Eardley St from Haydon Dr will avoid the majority of traffic controls in place during an event. Braybrooke Street and Battye Street experience the heaviest traffic flows during an event so avoiding these roads if possible is recommended.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS BEFORE AND DURING AN EVENT:

- Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street can only be accessed via Battye Street.
- Vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street are advised to exit via Braybrooke Street as there will be no right turn permitted on to Battye Street.
- Vehicles that choose to leave Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street by turning left onto Battye Street will need to then turn left into Leverrier Crescent and then left onto Masterman Street.
- Watkins Street may only be accessed via Thynne Street and not via Battye Street.

POST-EVENT TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS:

- Vehicle access to Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street will only be via a right turn of Battye St, after turning right onto Battye St from Leverrier Crescent.
- There will be no vehicle access to Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street from the Haydon Drive end of Battye Street. Access to Battye Street from Haydon Drive will be blocked to all traffic heading towards GIO Stadium.
- Vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street after events are advised to do so by turning right onto Battye Street or left onto Braybrooke Street. There will be no left turn into Battye Street after the event.
- Watkins Street may only be accessed via Thynne Street and not via Battye Street.
- A temporary taxi rank will be in service outside the main entrance to GIO Stadium during event times.
- Community drop-off points are located on the Eastern side of Leverrier Street and can be accessed from the Northern end of Leverrier Street only whilst traffic controls are in place.
- A taxi rank is located on Battye Street at the Western entrance, and ACTION buses will arrive and depart from the Eastern gate.
