GIO STADIUM TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS FOR MAJOR EVENTS

Dear Resident,

GIO Stadium will host a range of sporting and entertainment events in 2021, providing an opportunity for Canberrans to experience the excitement of live sport and entertainment on a regular basis.

Alternative traffic arrangements will be established for each major event in the areas surrounding the stadium to ensure there is minimal traffic congestion caused by the influx of spectators. Modified traffic arrangements will be in place throughout each event beginning up to two hours prior to gate opening times and concluding up to one hour after each event.

On event days, modified traffic arrangements will be implemented on Haydon Drive, Battye Street, Braybrooke Street and Masterman Street in Bruce, and residents living in this area may experience delays.

Changes throughout the season may occur due to any future restrictions that may occur due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. For updated information regarding COVID-19 in the ACT, please visit www.covid19.act.gov.au.

AVOIDING TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ON EVENT DAYS:

The best way to avoid traffic management measures and potential delays is to enter the Bruce precinct via Eardley St from Haydon Dr prior to, during and immediately after an event. Braybrooke Street and Battye Street experience the heaviest traffic flows during an event so avoiding these roads if possible is recommended.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS BEFORE AND DURING AN EVENT:

- Proximity Apartments, the Bowery Residences and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street can only be accessed from Battye Street.
- Vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments, the Bowery Residences and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street are advised to exit onto Braybrooke Street towards Ginninderra Dr as there will be no right turn permitted onto Battye Street.
- Vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments, and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street will need to turn left onto Battye Street and then left onto Leverrier Crescent and then left again onto Masterman Street to exit the precinct.
- Watkin Street is best accessed via Thynne Street, not Battye Street.

POST-EVENT TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS:

- Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street will only be accessed via a right turn onto Leverrier Crescent and then onto Battye Street.
- Access to Battye Street from Haydon Drive will be blocked to all traffic heading towards GIO Stadium. There will be no vehicle access to Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street from the Haydon Drive end of Battye Street.
- The Bowery Residences will be accessed via southbound travel on Braybrooke Street from Ginninderra Drive. Please note that access via Battye Street will not be possible.
- There will be no left turn onto Battye Street for vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments, the Bowery Residences and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street.
- Watkin Street may only be accessed via Thynne Street and not via Battye Street.

Community drop-off points are located out the front of the AIS Arena, accessed from the northern end of Leverrier Street whilst traffic controls are in place.

A taxi rank is located on Battye Street at the west entrance to GIO Stadium, and public buses will arrive and depart from the east gate.
