





# GIO Stadium traffic arrangements for major events

### Dear Resident,

GIO Stadium Canberra will host a range of events in 2025, providing an opportunity for Canberrans to experience the excitement of live sport and entertainment on a regular basis.

To ensure there is minimal traffic congestion caused by the influx of spectators for these major events, alternative traffic arrangements will be established for the areas surrounding the Stadium. Modified traffic arrangements will commence up to two hours prior to gate opening times and will continue throughout the event and up to one hour once an event concludes.

On game days, modified traffic arrangements will be implemented on Haydon Drive, Battye Street, Braybrooke Street and Masterman Street in Bruce. Residents living in this area may experience delays. The ACT Government would like to thank you for your support of events at GIO Stadium Canberra, and your patience and understanding during these events.

### Avoiding traffic management on event days:

The best way to avoid traffic management measures and potential delays is to enter the Bruce precinct via Eardley Street from Haydon Drive prior to, during and immediately after an event.

Braybrooke Street and Battye Street experience the heaviest traffic flows during an event so avoiding these roads if possible is recommended.

# Traffic arrangements before and during an event:

- Proximity Apartments, the Bowery Residences and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street can only accessed via Battye Street.
- Vehicles leaving Proximity Apartments, the Bowery Residences and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Street are advised to exit via Braybrooke Street towards Ginninderra Drive as there will be no right turn permitted onto Battye Street.
- Vehicles that choose to leave Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Streets by turning left onto Battye Street will need to then turn left into Leverrier Crescent and then left onto Masterman Street.
- Watkins Street is best accessed via Thynne Street not via Battye Street.

### Post-event traffic arrangements:

- Access to Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Streets will only be via a right turn off Battye St, after turning right onto Battye Street from Leverrier Crescent.
- Access to Battye Street from Haydon Drive will be blocked to all traffic heading towards GIO Stadium and due to this, there will be no vehicle access to Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Streets from the Haydon Drive end of Battye Street.
- Access to the Bowery Residences is via Southbound travel on Braybrooke Street from Ginninderra Drive. Please note that Access via Battye Street will not be possible.
- Vehicles leaving the Proximity Apartments and businesses located at the intersection of Battye and Braybrooke Streets after events are advised to do so by turning right onto Battye Street. There will be no left turn into Battye Street after an event.
- Watkins Street may only be accessed via Thynne Street - not via Battye Street.

Community drop-off points are located out the front of the AIS Arena and on the Eastern side of Leverrier Street, accessed from the Northern end of Leverrier Street whilst traffic controls are in place.

A taxi rank is located on Battye Street at the Western entrance to GIO Stadium Canberra. Public buses will arrive and depart from the Eastern gate.
